

CMC SCHOOLS-CAMPUS CULTURE

- Carmel Convent School is proud of eco-friendly, serene and peaceful environment .the day starts with morning meditation and prayer ,which connects the entire Carmel family with the divine, thus enabling them to seek the blessings of God before they start the day.
- Deeply committed to all ethical values this institution expects its students and staff to conduct themselves in an appropriate manner especially with respect to their dress, demeanor and discipline. Students must respect their teachers and the management ;greet them politely, while in or out of the school campus, students must speak English in the school campus. Use of abusive language,nick names, teasing others,fighting etc. are punishable.
- Students ought to be seated in their respective class rooms at the stroke of the first bell. Unnecessary movement of the students in the corridors of the school building during lecture hours is not permitted. Climbing the rails of the school corridors and stairs is strictly prohibited.
- It is mandatory for the students to carry their identity cards. students must avoid gathering in front of the school gate, especially after the school hours are over.
- Decorum and discipline at all times ,both inside and outside the campus must be observed. Those guilty of serious misconduct detrimental to the school discipline are liable to be expelled. Code of conduct in the campus includes safeguarding the school property,keeping the place clean and tidy and following the prescribed dress code.
- Students are expected to dress formally, modestly and neatly as per the school specifications. Body piercing of any kind

tattooing, fancy hair colouring, fashionable haircuts etc. will not be allowed.

- Use of mobile phones and other electronic gadget is strictly prohibited. If found the same shall be confiscated and will not be returned.
- Students/parents are not permitted to make complaints or presenting petitions collectively but are welcome to present their case, if any, either individually or through their proper representatives.
- Attending the online classes, if any with cameras on and in uniform is expected.

FEES

The school fees are collecting in three termly instalments. Parents are recommended to use the bank facilities to pay fees. Bus fees are collecting monthly before 10th of every month. It is obligatory to settle all fees before examinations. School fees are subject to revision and shall be binding on all when such revisions are made.

CONVEYANCE

School buses run on specific routes for the conveyance of students. Payment should be made in advance at the beginning of each month. The bus will collect/drop students at authorized boarding points only. The Student must show their fee card to enter in the Bus.

CARMEL BOARDING HOUSE

Attached to this school there is the Carmel Boarding House providing accommodation for girl students from class V.



LIBRARY RULES

Library is open from 9.00 am to 4.00 pm on working days and from 9 am to 1.30 pm on holidays. Students are advised to use library facilities as much as possible.

- 1. Strict silence shall be observed in the library.
- 2. No damage shall be caused to the library books.
- 3. If a book is lost or damaged, it shall be replaced by the student who is liable.
- 4. Magazines and periodicals will not be issued from the library.

Note:

- 1. Mobile Phones are not allowed in the school campus.
- 2. Students are not supposed to bring chewing gums.
- 3. Boys are not allowed, to wear low waist pants. Boys hair cut should be normal.
- 4. The wearing of the prescribed uniform is obligatory on all days. Students are not allowed to wear any ornaments & fancy items.
- 5. On birthdays they can wear colour dress. But not allowed to distribute any eatables on any days.

- To make the right choices and the right decisions when faced with conflicting situations.
- To be selfless in the service of their fellow human beings, and to become agents of needed social transformation.
- To inculcate the values of Kingdom, respect for life and love for nature by caring for the earth and environment.
- To promote Indian heritage and culture.
- To contribute to the buildings up of integrated and loving families.
- To analyze the impact of media and globalization on the society, family and the youth.
- To foster respect for other religions.
- To encourage participation and team spirit.
- To achieve academic excellence.
- To help them acquire the right scientific temperament attitude and competency, enabling them to respond to the needs and challenge of modern world.
- To build awareness among them of the present day social conditions and to challenge them to play their positive and creative role in the building up of the nation.

RECOMMENDATION TO PARENTS

The school recognizes parents as the chief educators of their children. Therefore it sees their cooperation and involvement as of utmost importance. They should acquaint themselves with the vision, philosophy and policy of the school through actively collaborating with the school in its efforts to reach out to the masses through its programmes and other attempts in making the school community an effective agent of social change. The management hopes to ensure this participation and partnership among the management, staff and parents through regular parent teacher meetings, informal contacts with parents etc.

Children should not be forced to study for longer periods. Private tuition is absolutely forbidden without prior discussion with the Principal and her consent except in exceptional cases where a child has missed classes due to prolonged illness. Nutrition is injurious to genuine progress, as the child is not encouraged to learn selfstudy skills and is prone to being inattentive distracted and indisciplined in the class. Achild has tremendous potential hidden in her/him which needs to be tapped. Self study improves thinking and concentration

and builds confidence in the child. Private tuition makes them dependent. Good eating habits, personal time-table for work, study, rest and recreation will discipline the life of a child. Parents are requested not to approach the school teachers for private tuition. Rather, they should urge the child to be regular and attentive in the class room learning process.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR THE PUPIL

1. In relation to God:

- Develop your relationship with Him through prayer and participation in the religious life of the school.
- Behave in a God-like way in your dealings with others, modelling His tolerance love, respect, fairness and honesty at all times.
- See your school life as a part of your mission on the earth and strive to fulfil it to the best of your ability.
- Always speak the truth with your parents, teachers and fellow students.

2. In relation to school community:

- School is your second home, love it and it will make you great
- Wear the school uniform correctly and with pride. Attend class on the opening day after each vacation.
- Reach the school at least five minutes before the assembly.
- Speak positively of your school and teachers.
- Show school spirit by participating in school activities
- Be responsible for your belongings. The name, class and section are to be written clearly on them.
- Do not wear ornaments, expensive watches etc. Keep your class rooms and school enviornment clean and tidy.
- Co-operate with all staff members and show due respect to them.
- Do not leave the school premises without the written permission of the Principal or Vice Principal.

- Be proud of your school and present a good image especially by behaving yourself when in public and particularly on your way to school.
- Read or listen to messages and do as instructed.
- Speak in English within the class rooms and school premises.
- Be regular in attending classes and doing your home work and other assignments.
- Make full use of the Library. Maintain silence in the library.
- Keep off verandahas, staircases and classrooms during recess/ lunch breaks.
- Make necessary arrangements to stay back after school hours to participate in academic, sports and cocurricular activities whenever required.
- Respect school property and report immediately of any damage to school property.
- Restrain yourself from reading literature that feeds the passions, leaving the mind disturbed.
- Do not meet any visitors in the school without the permission of the Principal / Vice - Principal.
- Do not use unfair means during tests. Such improper conducts is unworthy of a student of Carmel Senior Sec. School and can lead to severe penalties.
- Bring relevant text books for all periods.
 Do not bring comics, story books etc. which will distract you from your studies.
- Carrying and use of mobile phones, memory cards, pendrives, CD/DVDs, portable hard discs etc. are strictly prohibited within the school campus. The violation of this is liable to suspension from the school and repeated violation will lead to dismissal from the school.

3. In relation to your teachers:

Show them courtesy and respect at all times.



- Accept their authority, their right to give instructions, and to allocate suitable correction to those who break rules.
- Love your teachers and never speak ill of them.
- Come to school on time and bring all necessary materials with you.
- Listen attentively when teachers and others are speaking. Indicate your desire to contribute by raising your hand.
- Avoid any distracting behaviour during lessons. Co-operate with the class monitor in maintaining proper order and discipline during change of periods and when the teacher happens to be absent or late.
- Put up your hand to ask/answer questions.

4. In relation to your fellow students

- Do not interfere with their personal matters by bullying or by indulging in violence.
- Do not detract their good name by insults or spreading rumours.
- Do not interfere with their chances to learn by disrupting the class room enviornment.
- Do not take and spoil materials belonging to others. Speak to them with courtesy and respect.
- Do not pick up quarrels with your fellow students.
- Help the weak students to cope up with their studies.
- Be responsible for your actions and accept their consequences.

4. In relation to your parents

- Respect them and obey them.
- Communicate all the messages given in the school.
- Remind them to meet the teacher on the prescribed date to enquire about your progress in the school.
- Try to be independent in getting ready for the school without bothering your parents.
- Do not tell lies or hide matters from your parents.
